## NOTICE OF DATE OF COMMENCEMENT OF PERIOD FOR THE EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2017

The Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2015 (SI 2015 No.234)  
The Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014

1. Date of announcement: **7<sup>th</sup> June 2017**
2. Sections 26 and 27 of the Local Audit Accountability Act 2014 provide for:
  - Any person interested has the opportunity to inspect and make copies of the annual return and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts etc. relating to them. For the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 these documents will be available on reasonable notice on application to the person in paragraph 3 below.
  - Local Government Electors and their representatives have rights to:
    - question the auditor about the accounts; and
    - object to the accounts or any item in them. Written notice of an objection must first be given to the auditor and a copy sent to Yeovil Town Council.
