## **Yeovil's New Look Town Guide**

Yeovil's New Town Guide has been launched this week with a fresh new look.

David Recardo - Mayor of Yeovil, officially introduced the guide at Ninesprings Café, Yeovil Country Park and thanked the contributors and publishers for all their hard work.

Yeovil is promoted by a contemporary new look and superb photographs. The 48 pages are packed with up-to-date information about the Town's many attractions, events and activities as well as street plans, a mini-history of the Town and a list of useful contacts. The publication also includes details of Yeovil's excellent shopping and leisure facilities, and things to do in the local area.

7,500 copies of the guide have been produced and the Town Council is grateful to all the local shops and businesses that have advertised in the guide and made this publication possible. For the first time, the guide has been locally produced and the publishers commissioned former Yeovil College art student, Graham Moores to provide stunning artwork for the front cover.

Whilst the guide is primarily aimed at visitors to the Town, it contains a wealth of information about Yeovil District Hospital, local High Schools and Yeovil College - which will be of particular interest to families who are thinking of moving to the Town.
