The Financial Strategy

The financial strategy is to deliver a balanced budget (meaning that reserves are not used to meet ongoing expenditure) whilst keeping Council Tax to a minimum. The Council look to make saving and efficiencies as well as explore new ways to generate income.

Precept

The precept for Yeovil Town Council for the financial year 2023/24 was set at £1,335,693, meaning that for a Band D property, the Council's share of Council Tax is £145.13 (an increase of £2.54 from 2022/23).
