11/1 ELECTION OF MAYOR OF YEOVIL TOWN – 2022/23

Cllr Evie Potts-Jones, Mayor of Yeovil, called for nominations for the office of Mayor of Yeovil Town for 2022/23.

It was proposed by Cllr A Kendall and seconded by Cllr J Snell that Cllr Evie Potts-Jones be elected as Mayor of Yeovil.

(At this point 7:32pm, the meeting was adjourned and Cllr Evie Potts-Jones left the meeting).

Cllr A Kendall and then Cllr J Snell spoke in support of the nomination.

It was proposed by Cllr E Potts-Jones and seconded by Cllr W Read that Cllr Andy Kendall be elected as Deputy Mayor of Yeovil.

Cllr E Potts-Jones and then Cllr W Read spoke in support of the nomination for Cllr Andy Kendall.

RESOLVED: Cllr Andy Kendall be elected to serve as Deputy Mayor of Yeovil Town for the ensuing year.

Cllr Andy Kendall returned to the meeting and then made and signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office.
