#### 11/138. YEOVIL ARTS AND HERITAGE WORKING GROUP REPORT

Yeovil Arts and Heritage Working Group met in May. There were representantives from Yeovil Town Council, South West Heritage Trust, Larel Miller Consulting, Yeovil Art Space, A-Z Yeovil History, University of West of England (UWE), South Somerset Heritage Collection, Yeovil Press and the Curatorial Group.

The purpose of the meeting was to re-visit the vision, mission and aims of the group as very successful "Story of Yeovil" project was coming to a close. The group structure and working processes were also considered with a way forward agreed which would support the funding application and timing of proposals to meet the heritage needs of the town.

Laurel Miller Consulting and UWE were very complimentary about the work carried out by the Yeovil Arts and Heritage Working Group in the delivery of a heritage project delivered uniquely in challenging time and environment. The Group recognised that the circumstances had challenged their methods of project delivery which had resulted in innovative experiences and solutions. These had been held as outstanding examples to communities who were able to deliver more traditional building/location-based access to heritage as an opportunity to try a different approach.

**2230** Beacon to be turned off and de-rig to commence

Plans for a respectful remembrance event are progressing well. Love Yeovil CIC have confirmed the bell ringers, Abbey 104 and the Heron band to play as per the schedule above.

Love Yeovil have also approached, Palmers Fish and Chips, Cow and Apple, The Acorn and Barolo to see if they would like to offer a special D-day fish and chip dish on the day, as it is national fish and chip day, with the dish having many significant links to the war. So far Acorn and Cow and Apple have both confirmed involvement.

A press release will be going out this week advertising the event and encouraging people to attend with a picnic to listen to the music and watch the beacon being lit. A practice run of the lighting the beacon has been conducted to ensure everything goes smoothly on the night.
