11/081. YEOVIL CELEBRATES FEEDBACK AND PROPOSAL

Review

The "Yeovil Celebrates!" event held on 27th and 28th May was a huge success and Yeovil Town Council is very grateful to all the businesses and organisations who made the event possible.

The feedback received was extremely positive. The team were commended on a very well organised event from the perspective of the participants and the visitors. We have received emails congratulating us on a brilliant community weekend with some requesting the opportunity to attend a future event and requests that it takes place annually.

Over 8,000 people came through the gates over the two days. Security stringently monitored capacity and regulated attendance to ensure the safety of all. The security team's role was also to check bags for prohibited items and some confiscations were made, however there was little resistance to this process as it was explained that the safety of everyone was paramount.

It is worth noting the comment, relating to the previous event, made at the report prior to the decision to hold this event:

"It was a long and exhausting day and if a similar event were to be planned in the future, adequate staffing would be required to safeguard the wellbeing of staff and volunteers; there would be an expectation that everyone within the Council would need to be involved before during and after the event."

Additional stewards were hired in this year to ensure that every aspect of the day had the appropriate personnel to cover the tasks required. Thanks are extended to the Councillors who worked very hard in setting up, on the event day, and clearing up the day after.

Recommendation

Following the positive feedback it is proposed that "Yeovil Celebrates!" takes place again next year with a suggested budget of £75,000 which will allow for inflation and potentially enable us to enhance the event.

RECOMMENDED

- (1) to note the report;
- (2) to hold the event again next year on 25th and 26th May; and
- (3) if (2) be agreed, to recommend a budget of £75,000 to Policy, Resources and Finance Committee for approval.

The plans for Super Saturday this year include: eat:festivals, circus skills, stilt walker, walkabout act, buskfest and local community stalls. There will also be two performances of Pirate Taxi by Pirates of the Carabina and the Deputy Town Clerk is liaising with the Arts Engagement & Outreach Manager and the Quedam Manager to potentially programme another performance at the event.

There will still be some restrictions on the areas of the town available for use this year due to Yeovil Refresh, so the focus of the event will be St John's Churchyard and The Quedam.
